Hot Take #1: Data is more important than Al



Tragic Mistake #1: Pursuing Al when you don't have good data or metrics




Hot Take #2: No, you cannot "just add a little Al"



Tragic Mistake #2: Not involving your data people at all

Hot Take #3: It is never too early to talk, but it is often too late



Data scientists and data engineers can de-risk your Al and data efforts



Tragic Mistake #3: We want to build Al, but no one was responsible for data



Hot take #4: One conversation is not a collaboration



Collaborate regularly

e.g. invite data people to sprint planning and demos



Tragic Mistake #4: We had ONE conversation, and now the things we built don't work together



You can add Al to a product, but it will be painful
